to which payment well and truly to be made We bind our-
selves our heirs &c. jointly severally and firmly by these presents
sealed and dated this 10th day of January 1809 The condition of
the above obligation is such that Whereas there is a marriage
shortly intended to be solemnized between the above bound
William Shryock & Janey Commona in Now if there
should be no lawful cause to obstruct said marriage then
the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force and
